Welcome to the 2025 California Pepsi USBC Youth Championships. Enclosed is the tournament information needed for this year's event. The Pepsi handbook has the official entry forms that you will need for this year's event. We are back to our normal schedule – the District Finals will be held in March and the State Finals will be held in May. There will NOT be any league level qualifying – it will be a DIRECT ENTRY for youth entered in CA USBC certified youth leagues. Paperwork needs to be submitted on official Pepsi entry forms or with BLS through the youth league submitted by Youth Program Directors.

IMPORTANT: Late entries will NOT be accepted. Please submit paperwork postmarked by **FEBRUARY 18**. Enclosed is your District Director's contact and tournament information (dates/fees). Contact us immediately if you have received the wrong district information and we will get you the correct information as soon as possible. **PLEASE have all coaches and bowlers READ the TOURNAMENT INFORMATION & RULES carefully.** If you have any questions, please contact your District Director immediately.

This tournament is special and offers more than just scholarships. U8 & U10 Division bowlers can earn entries into the California Youth State Championships and U12, U15 & U18 Division bowlers can earn berths to the USBC Junior Gold Championships as well as travel stipends and free jerseys for Junior Gold.

Thank you for your support and participation in one of the largest scholarship events in California. With the rising cost of education, this tournament strongly benefits many young bowlers on their way to a promising future. Last year, we awarded over \$60,000 in scholarships. We have included a flyer with tournament dates and locations to display at your center in promoting this tournament.

NEW YOUTH TOURNAMENT

The California Youth Committee (CYC) is running the **CAL STATE YOUTH QUEENS & MASTERS / PRINCE & PRINCESS** event the same weekend as the Pepsi State Finals (May 3-4). This is a youth singles 5-gamer open to all current California youth bowlers. Bowlers who qualify for the Pepsi State Finals can pick a squad opposite from what they schedule for Pepsi since it will be held at Country Club Lanes, only 17 miles away from the Pepsi State Finals AMF Rocklin location. Bowlers can even bowl everything on Saturday, May 3 if they pick the morning squad for Pepsi and then bowl the QM/PP in the afternoon! We hope bowlers will take advantage of this great opportunity. CUSBC is donating \$2,000 in additional scholarships for this event! Sign up online at **CALUSBC.com**.





1. This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) and shall be governed by USBC rules.
2. Competition is open to all 2024-25 USBC Youth members that are bowling in a California USBC certified youth league and not under suspension. League substitutes are allowed to participate if it is their only California USBC certified youth league. Entries must be submitted through California USBC certified youth leagues.
3. Bowlers may choose to "OPT UP" into a higher age division. Bowlers must sign a wavier PRIOR to district competition and submit with entry fees. Participants must remain in the division they enter during all subsequent levels.
Participation in more than one District or State will result in automatic disqualification.

4. **District #5 Finals** competition will take place on **MARCH 22, 2025 at 1pm** and **MARCH 23, 2025 at 9am**.

5. **Entry closing date is FEBRUARY 18.** Tournament entry fees and entries containing qualifiers' name, address, phone and date of birth must be submitted by this date to the District Director. **On-site fees will not be accepted.** No refunds will be allowed after the closing date. **Checks or money orders will be accepted made payable to CUSBC. Write center name in memo. Any returned checks are subject to a \$35 penalty fee and must be paid with money order by MARCH 1. NO CASH ACCEPTED AND ONLY ONE CHECK PER CENTER.**

6. Divisions are based on the participant's age. Athletes must choose the division in which they will compete.
Competition shall be conducted in the following divisions:
 - U8 DIVISION: BOWLERS WHOSE BIRTHDATE IS 8/1/2016 OR LATER
 - U10 DIVISION: BOWLERS WHOSE BIRTHDATE IS 8/1/2014 THRU 7/31/16
 - U12 DIVISION: BOWLERS WHOSE BIRTHDATE IS 8/1/2012 THRU 7/31/14
 - U15 DIVISION: BOWLERS WHOSE BIRTHDATE IS 8/1/2009 THRU 7/31/12
 - U18 DIVISION: BOWLERS WHOSE BIRTHDATE IS 8/1/2006 THRU 7/31/09

7. **Format:** Three games bowled on the same pair of lanes. Total scratch pinfall will determine the standings for each division and will also determine the qualifying results from District to State for the U12, U15 & U18 divisions. **U8 & U10 divisions do not advance to the State Finals.**

9. **DRESS CODE:** All bowlers must wear suitable attire. Polo shirt (blank) or bowling jersey with or without name on the back. Collars must be hemmed (crew, v-neck, polo or quarter zip). All jerseys must have finished sleeves. All skirts, capris, skorts or walking shorts must be below the competitor's fingertips when they are standing with their arms hanging loosely at their side. Hats, gym shorts and yoga pants are not permitted. No electronic devices allowed in the bowler's area. Tournament management must approve any/all exceptions prior to the event. If the dress code is deemed unacceptable, the participant will be required to change immediately. If the participant is unable to change, they will be removed from competition for that day. Re-scheduling will be accommodated only when possible.

10. No substitutes permitted once the squad has started. Replacements may be used for scheduled bowlers not present at least 30 minutes prior to the squad time as stated in Rule 2. **Replacements must be from the same center, league and division based on their order of finish. Rule 322b will be waived.**
11. Tardy bowlers shall start in the frame currently being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Bowlers not present to bowl when it's their turn will receive a zero for that frame.
12. **AVERAGE VERIFICATION FOR HANDICAP SCHOLARSHIPS:**
 - a) Highest USBC certified league average (min. of 15 games) **AS OF FEBRUARY 15, 2025. ALL FALL LEAGUE SHEETS ENDING BEFORE FEBRUARY 15 ARE ALSO REQUIRED IF NOT POSTED ON BOWL.com.** If none,
 - b) Highest USBC certified league average as of the tournament date (min. of 15 games; sheet required). If none,
 - c) Highest USBC certified league average from 2023-24 (min. of 15 games). If none,
 - d) Scratch (175 for U8 & U10 divisions; 210 for U12, U15 & U18 divisions)
BOWLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR VERIFYING THEIR OWN AVERAGES. If a certified "sport/challenge" league average is the youth's only verifiable average, it will be adjusted per the chart in the USBC Rulebook to determine the correct entering average.

13. **Scratch and Handicap Scholarships will be awarded based on the number of paid entries with a ratio of at least 1:8 per division, or major fraction thereof.** Handicap for the U8 & U10 divisions is: 80% of 175 and Handicap for the U12, U15 & U18 divisions is: 100% of 210. Awards and Scholarship fees shall be returned 100%. All ties will be split equally. Scholarships will be held with USBC SMART Account #8512, (800) 514-2695 x8292. Special Olympic winners may opt to receive a gift card (maximum of \$300) in lieu of SMART scholarships if they are not attending college or a trade school. A CUSBC waiver must be signed in order to process the gift card.
14. **U8 & U10 Champions will earn a single entry (\$65 value) into the California Youth State Championships held on June 21-22, 2025 at 4th Street Bowl, San Jose.** In order to redeem this award, the winner must pay and enter with a full team of their choice in all three events (team, singles and doubles). The entry will be reimbursed after the tournament is completed and participation is verified. This berth is applicable only to the four Champions in each district and will be voided if they cannot attend or do not enter with a full team entry.
15. **Advancement from District competition to State competition (U12, U15 & U18 divisions only) is at least ONE FOR EVERY FOUR ENTRIES, or major fraction thereof, including last place ties per division using scratch scores.** The base number for each division is the number of individuals that were paid at the District Finals. In all cases at least one individual per division shall advance. The advancement ratio shall be applied to all eligible divisions. **IT IS THE BOWLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK ONLINE AT CALUSBC.COM TO SEE IF THEY ARE A STATE QUALIFIER. ALL STATE QUALIFIERS MUST REGISTER THEIR SQUAD TIME ONLINE APRIL 1-8 IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE FINALS.** Those who fail to register their squad time without prior notification to the Tournament Director will forfeit their spot. **NO ALTERNATES.** State Finals competition will take place at **AMF ROCKLIN LANES** on **MAY 3-4, 2025**. Squad times: Saturday 9am, Saturday 2pm and Sunday at 8:30am. **Format:** Five games scratch moving pairs after each game.
16. **Practice is prohibited** in the hosting center during the weekend of competition.
17. Only bowlers and Tournament Officials are permitted in the settee area.
18. **ONLY A DRY TOWEL FOR CLEANING MAY BE USED DURING COMPETITION. ELIMINATION OF BALANCE HOLES:** Bowlers may have up to five holes for gripping purposes and all must be used on every delivery. If only fingers are used, the thumb hole must be plugged and an "X" marked for the palm position. Any bowling ball that does not meet USBC specifications will subject the bowler to forfeiture. We reserve the option to do random spot checks and we may be reported to check equipment by another bowler. Any violation to these guidelines will result in disqualification and forfeiture of scholarships/entry fee. **Visit BOWL.com to download the Non-conforming Bowling Ball List.**
19. **DISQUALIFICATIONS:** Non-alcoholic beer may NOT be consumed while participating in the tournament. No tobacco or smoking products permitted by participants. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of youth bowling in conjunction with USBC will result in immediate disqualification (Refer to rule 17D). Adults consuming alcohol must remain in the lounge or in back concourse area.
20. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD ALLOWED INSIDE THE CENTER.** Please be respectful of the hosting center's rules and guidelines.
21. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the California Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Tournament Committee. The National Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.

FORMAT: NO ENTRY FEE. One-time entry. Five games singles moving pairs after each game. Each division will earn scratch and handicap scholarships and one of six berths into the 2025 USBC Junior Gold Championships in Wisconsin (if they have not already previously qualified). 2. Advancement from District to State is a one-time entry. If an individual qualified and cannot participate in state competition, replacements will be eligible based on order of finish in the previous competition. **NO ENTRY FEE.**
3. **Advancement from District competition to State competition (U12, U15 & U18 divisions only) is at least ONE FOR EVERY FOUR ENTRIES**, or major fraction thereof, including last place ties per division using scratch scores. The base number for each division is the number of individuals that were paid at the District Finals. In all cases at least one individual per division shall advance. The advancement ratio shall be applied to all eligible divisions. **IT IS THE BOWLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK ONLINE AT CALUSBC.COM TO SEE IF THEY ARE STATE QUALIFIERS. ALL STATE QUALIFIERS MUST REGISTER THEIR SQUAD TIME APRIL 1-8 IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE FINALS. Those who fail to register their squad time without prior notification to the Tournament Director will forfeit their spot.**
4. Advancers out of the league level must remain in the division they qualified in during all subsequent levels. If a bowler advances out of league level in more than one state, the bowler must declare one state to continue competing before the next competition level. Participation in any level of competition past the league level in more than one district/state will result in automatic disqualification.
5. State Finals competition will take place at **AMF ROCKLIN LANES**, 2325 Sierra Meadows Dr, Rocklin, CA 95677, (916) 624-8216 on **MAY 3-4, 2025**. Squad times: Saturday 9am, Saturday 2pm and Sunday at 8:30am.
6. Divisions are based on the participant's age. Athletes must compete in their proper age division in all levels of competition. Athletes must be Junior Gold Members or be eligible and buy membership prior to advancement to the Junior Gold Championships. **Competition shall be conducted in the following divisions:**
 - **U12 DIVISION: BOWLERS WHOSE BIRTHDATE IS 8/1/12 THRU 7/31/14**
 - **U15 DIVISION: BOWLERS WHOSE BIRTHDATE IS 8/1/09 THRU 7/31/12**
 - **U18 DIVISION: BOWLERS WHOSE BIRTHDATE IS 8/1/06 THRU 7/31/09**
7. **Format:** Five games moving pairs after each game. Total scratch pinfall will determine the standings for each division.
9. **DRESS CODE: BOWLING JERSEY WITH NAME ON THE BACK.** *Collars must be hemmed (crew, v-neck, polo or quarter zip). All jerseys must have finished sleeves. Male participants are required to wear slacks with front zipper and button at waist. Slacks must not contain drawstring waists or elastic bottoms. Female participants are required to wear slacks, skirts, capris, skorts or walking shorts. All skirts, capris, skorts or walking shorts must be below the competitor's fingertips when they are standing with their arms hanging loosely at their side. Hats, jeans and yoga pants are not permitted. No electronic devices allowed in the bowler's area. Tournament management must approve any/all exceptions prior to the event. If the dress code is deemed unacceptable, the participant will be required to change immediately. If the participant is unable to change, they will be removed from competition for that day. Re-scheduling will be accommodated only when possible.*
10. No replacements permitted once the squad has started. Replacements may be used for scheduled bowlers not present at least 30 minutes prior to the squad time as stated in Rule 2. **Replacements must be from the same center, league and division based on their order of finish. Rule 322b will be waived.**
11. Tardy bowlers shall start in the frame currently being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Bowlers not present to bowl when it's their turn will receive a zero for that frame.
12. Scratch and Handicap scholarships will be awarded based on the number of participants with a ratio of at least 1:8 per division, with a major fraction thereof. **Handicap is 100% of 210 using District Finals averages.** Awards and Scholarship fees shall be returned 100%. All ties will be split equally. Scholarships will be held with USBC SMART under account #8512, (800) 514-2695 x8292. Special Olympic winners may opt to receive a gift card (maximum of \$300) in lieu of SMART scholarships if they are not attending college or trade school. A CUSBC waiver must be signed in order to process the gift card.

STATE RULES

13. **California is allocated 6 berths into the Junior Gold Championships. The first-place winners of the U12, U15 and U18 divisions for both Girls and Boys will advance to the 2025 Junior Gold Championships.** Berth winners must be USBC Junior Gold members to advance to the Junior Gold Championships. Bowlers without a current Junior Gold membership must purchase a Junior Gold membership prior to June 8. IBC Youth will waive the \$200 (U18), \$150 (U15), and \$100 (U12) entry fee for these athletes. These athletes will compete for additional scholarships available to all athletes at the Junior Gold Championships, as well as other prizes and awards. All U.S. citizens are vying for a spot on USBC Junior Team USA 2026 to represent the United States in national and international competition. If the U12, U15 or U18 Division Champion is unwilling to become a Junior Gold member, they will not advance to the Junior Gold Championships. However, the athlete will still retain the state scholarship, but the berth to the Junior Gold Championships will be awarded to the next eligible athlete. Eligible advancers must agree to bowl in the Junior Gold Championships, or, failing to do so, agree to waive all rights. Replacements will be selected based on the order of finish in their division at the state level. In the event that a qualifier needs to be replaced and there is a tie to determine who will advance to the Junior Gold Championships, the highest game from the qualifying scores will determine who will advance. If the high score for each is the same, the next subsequent high score will be used until the tie is broken. Replacements will incur all costs associated with changing the airline ticket, if applicable. **The California USBC Association will provide the U12, U15 & U18 Champions (6 total) a travel stipend valued up to \$500 and a Strike12Creations.com jersey.** The jersey and stipend are offered only for the champions attending the Jr Gold Championships and is non-transferrable. If the champion does not attend the Junior Gold Championships, the jersey and stipend will be forfeited. Arrangements will be made by each athlete within stated guidelines and parameters from the California USBC Association. **Junior Gold berth winners are not confirmed until they receive confirmation from USBC.**
14. Only bowlers and Tournament Officials are permitted in the settee area.
15. **Practice is prohibited** in the hosting center during the weekend of competition (Saturday night).
16. **ONLY A DRY TOWEL FOR CLEANING MAY BE USED DURING COMPETITION. ELIMINATION OF BALANCE HOLES:** Bowlers may have up to five holes for gripping purposes and all must be used on every delivery. If only fingers are used, the thumb hole must be plugged and an "X" marked for the palm position. Any bowling ball that does not meet USBC specifications will subject the bowler to disqualification of all tournament scores. We reserve the option to do random spot checks and we may be reported to check equipment by another bowler. **Visit BOWL.com to download the Non-conforming Bowling Ball List.**
17. Food and drinks are permissible in the back area only. **DISQUALIFICATIONS:** Non-alcoholic beer may NOT be consumed while participating in the tournament. No tobacco or smoking products permitted by participants. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of youth bowling in conjunction with USBC will result in immediate disqualification (Refer to rule 17D). Adults consuming alcohol must remain in the lounge or in back concourse area.
18. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD ALLOWED INSIDE THE CENTER.** Please be respectful of the hosting center's rules and guidelines.
19. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the California Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Tournament Committee. The National Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.

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
