### **RULE 18: ONLY A DRY TOWEL FOR CLEANING MAY BE USED DURING COMPETITION. ELIMINATION OF**

**BALANCE HOLES:** Bowlers may have up to five holes for gripping purposes and all holes must be used on every delivery. If only fingers are used, the thumb hole must be plugged and an "X" marked for the palm position. Any bowling ball that does not meet USBC specifications will subject the bowler to disqualification of all scores. Random spot checks may be performed and we may be reported to check equipment by another bowler.

#### RULES FOR THE CALIFORNIA USBC YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025 (Web: CALUSBC.com)

The California USBC Youth Championships Tournament is certified by USBC. **YOUTH PROGRAM DIRECTORS/CONTACTS/CAPTAINS:** The rules and information are important and should be read carefully before the entry is completed. **Entry forms not filled in properly and completely will be returned.** 

- 1. Youth members with current California USBC certified membership and league averages are eligible to participate. NO CARDS SOLD ON-SITE BY CUSBC.
- 2. Bowlers must check in at least ONE HOUR prior to scheduled squad time with current USBC membership card. Walk-ins must provide BOWL.com average verifications at check-in or enter at 210 for brackets.
- 3. **PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED:** Handicapped bowlers requiring aids such as crutches, canes, wheelchairs, etc., or who are blind must report this in writing when entry is submitted so that special schedule consideration can be arranged. Similar additional notice must be given if such a handicapped bowler is to be used as a replacement.
- 4. ENTRY FEES: Team and Singles event: \$14.25 lineage + \$9.75 awards/scholarships + \$1 scholarships = \$25 per person/per event. Make checks payable to: CUSBC. Write "Youth Championships" in check memo. Any returned checks must be paid in cash or money order prior to competition plus a \$35 penalty fee. Zelle: 562-449-4527; Venmo: @calusbcbowling2 and Paypal: info@calusbc.com accepted for payment. Put bowler's name in note. No refunds once an entry has been scheduled, unless CUSBC is notified in writing within 15 days of the schedule notice mailing date that the date and time assigned is not acceptable.
- 5. Teams may consist of any four youth members. No partial teams accepted.
- 6. **RE-ENTRIES:** Team may be bowled more than once as long as **at least two members** in the line-up are changed. Re-entries are based on squad availability. Singles event may be bowled more than once, but you can earn scholarships only once in the top 10.
- ENTRY CLOSING DATE: JUNE 22, 2025 unless all squads are filled sooner. NO entry accepted unless accompanied by full payment.
- 8. ADVANCED RESERVATIONS MUST SUBMIT PAYMENT AND OFFICIAL ENTRY FORMS BY MAY 15. Failure to do so will result in loss of the reserved date and a refund will be issued if applicable.

#### 9. ENTERING AVERAGES:

- A) Highest 2024-25 USBC certified book average, mininum of 15 games. If none,
- B) Highest USBC certified current average as of the tournament date, mininum of 15 games (league sheet required). If none,
- C) Highest 2023-24 USBC certified book average, mininum of 15 games. If none,
- D) Highest 2023-24 USBC composite certified book average, mininum of 15 games. If none,
- E) Enter at 210 scratch

VERIFICATION IS REQUIRED OF ALL AVERAGES:
Include all applicable league sheets with entry forms
(if necessary). Bowlers are responsible for verifying
their own averages. If a "sport" or "challenge"
average is the bowler's only verifiable average, it will
be adjusted per the USBC sport average chart. PLEASE
SUBMIT A COPY OF EACH BOWLER'S BOWL.COM
AVERAGE/MEMBERSHIP PRINTOUT WITH ENTRY.

- 10. This is a handicapped event. Handicap: 90% of 210.
- 11. Three games per event.
- 12.Line-up changes must be requested at least one week prior to the time the entrants are scheduled to bowl.
- 13. REPLACEMENTS: Replacements must take the place in the line up of the original entrant. NO absentee scores allowed. USBC Rule 322b will be waived. Replacements must be processed at least one hour prior to the time the entrant(s) are scheduled to bowl. If a replacement is not available, the missing bowler will receive zeros. Scholarships will be paid to the replacement bowler unless prior arrangements are made.
- 14. Bowlers arriving late or not present to bowl when it's their turn will be credited with a zero.
- 15. No practice allowed for lanes that have been moved due to breakdowns.
- 16. This tournament uses one lane courtesy only. No pacers.
- 17. Food and drink in the bowlers' area is prohibited. Spectators are not allowed in the bowlers area.

#### RULES FOR THE CALIFORNIA USBC YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025 (Web: CALUSBC.com)

DURING COMPETITION. ELIMINATION OF BALANCE
HOLES: Bowlers may have up to five holes for gripping
purposes and all holes must be used on every delivery. If
only fingers are used, the thumb hole must be plugged and
an "X" marked for the palm position. Any bowling ball that
does not meet USBC specifications will subject the bowler
to disqualification of all tournament scores. We reserve the
option to do random spot checks and we may be reported
to check equipment by another bowler. Visit BOWL.com

18. ONLY A DRY TOWEL FOR CLEANING MAY BE USED

Rule Acknowledgement box on entry.

- 19.BOWLING ATTIRE: All bowlers must wear suitable attire. This is a Championship event. Polo shirt (blank) or bowling jersey with or without name on the back. Collars must be hemmed (crew, v-neck, polo or quarter zip). All jerseys must have finished sleeves. All skirts, capris, skorts or walking shorts must be below the competitor's fingertips when they are standing with their arms hanging loosely at their side. NOT ALLOWED: Hats, workout clothes, clothing torn, ripped or with holes; short-shorts; halter-tops or "cut-offs". NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES ALLOWED IN THE BOWLER'S AREA. Tournament management must approve any/all exceptions prior to the event. If the dress code is deemed unacceptable, the participant will be required to change immediately or not participate. Tournament Management must approve any/all exceptions prior to competition.
- 20. AWARDS: Symbolic awards will be provided for division champions only. Scholarships will be awarded based on a ratio of at least 1:8 or major fraction thereof in each division/event. All awards and scholarship fees collected shall be returned 100%. In case of ties, duplicate awards will be made. Special Olympic winners may opt to receive a gift card (maximum of \$500) in lieu of SMART scholarships if they are not attending college or trade school. Parameters to be set by California USBC. Scholarships will be held in the USBC SMART program under account #10717, (800) 514-2695 x8292. Scholarships will be reported to SMART within 30 days upon completion of the tournament.
- 21. **DISQUALIFICATIONS:** Non-alcoholic beer may NOT be consumed while participating in tournament. Adults consuming alcohol must remain in the lounge or in back concourse area. No tobacco or smoking products permitted by any bowler during the tournament. **Conduct derogatory to the best interest of youth bowling in conjunction with USBC will result in immediate disqualification (Refer to rule 17D).**
- 22. The Tournament Director shall be the authority to interpret USBC rules and state tournament rules, policies and procedures in deciding disputes. If deemed necessary, the Tournament Director shall consult with the Board of Directors of the California USBC.
- 23. Any protest or appeal concerning scoring must be made in writing and submitted to the CUSBC within 72 hours after the infraction has occurred. The decision of USBC is final and binding on all involved parties.
